

OUR COMMITMENTS TO MACEIÓ

People’s safety is Braskem’s priority.

Since 2019, this remains **our greatest commitment** to Maceió and its residents. We recognize the social impact caused and for this reason, we diligently implemented actions.

The evacuation of the risk area is **complete** and has been carried out in **conjunction with authorities** in a proactive manner and focused on safeguarding lives. In four years, about 40,000 people were **proactively relocated**. So far, **99.8% of the total financial compensation proposals have already been presented** to families and merchants operating in the evacuation areas and **94% have been paid**. The remaining proposals continue to be submitted, to complete payments **in the shortest possible time**.

We continue to work diligently to repair, mitigate, and compensate for the impacts of soil subsidence and the evacuation of the affected sections in Maceió, with a dedicated team of **more than 1,000 professionals** in various areas – social technicians, lawyers, architects, environmentalists, engineers, agronomists, geologists,

psychologists, veterinarians, janitorial teams, property security, and many others.

Because it is not enough to just relocate residents. We need to identify, recognize, and act on the impacts on their lives. Support them in resuming their lives. And collaborate with the government to improve the city in which they live.

Over the past four years, we have been **reaffirming these commitments to Maceió** through **actions and programs on the social, urban, and environmental fronts** widely discussed with the public authorities, society, and affected communities. Many have already been approved and are in the early stage of implementation.

These actions and programs are part of the **agreements signed with the authorities**, which are inspected and strictly fulfilled. The resources already reserved are BRL 14.4 billion and include disbursements made directly by Braskem or transfers to public authorities. **More than BRL 9.2 billion has already been used.**
