

NOTICE ON RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Parties	Braskem S.A. ("Braskem") and Companhia de Gás do Estado do Rio Grande do Sul ("Sulgás")
Relationship with the issuer	Sulgás is a joint venture controlled by Petrobras Gás S.A. – Gaspetro (subsidiary of Petróleo Brasileiro S.A Petrobras) and MitsuiGás e Energia do Brasil, according to information in the Financial Statements of Petrobras. Meanwhile, Petrobras holds 47.03% of the voting capital and 36.15% of the total capital of Braskem.
Purpose	Agreement that regulates the supply by Sulgás to Braskem of natural gas, via local gas distribution pipeline.
Key terms and conditions	(i) Supply by Sulgás of piped natural gas to Braskem's unit in Triunfo, Rio Grande do Sul, with Contracted Volume of 200,000 m³/day;
	(ii) Agreement amount: R\$130,928,420.00;
	(iii) Effective term of the agreement: January 22, 2021 to December 31, 2021.
	(iv) Termination events: by mutual agreement of the parties; partial or full transfer to third parties, without prior written authorization from the other party, of their rights and obligations under the agreement; judicially, under the law; by Braskem, provided that it notifies Sulgás at least three (3) months in advance and pays the amount proportional to the time remaining until the expiration of the contractual term.
Date of execution of the agreement	March 12, 2021
Any participation by the counterparty, its partners or managers in the issuer's decision-making process or in the negotiation of the transaction as representatives of the issuer	Petrobras, its partners or managers have not participated in Braskem's decision process or negotiation of the transaction, with the directors appointed by Petrobras abstaining from voting on the operation at the relevant Braskem's Board of Directors Meeting.



Detailed justification of the reasons why the management of the issuer believes the transaction was carried out on an arm's length basis or involves adequate compensatory payment

Sulgás is the exclusive concessionaire of public services for the distribution of piped natural gas in the state of Rio Grande do Sul.

The natural gas market is regulated by the Rio Grande do Sul State Infrastructure and Environmental Department and the National Petroleum, Natural Gas and Biofuels Agency (ANP). Accordingly, this agreement strictly complies with the legislation in force, including in terms of the fees and conditions adopted.
